Catherine Cameron

God, Who Stretched the Spangled Heaven (#24) uses a 20<sup>th</sup> century text with a 19<sup>th</sup> century tune. It was authored by Catherine Arnott Cameron (b.1927), a former University of La Verne (CA) faculty member. Although originally set to another tune, it is best known with the tune, "Holy Manna." Many would identify this melody with the hymn "Christians/Brethren, We Have Met to Worship" (#396) and "All Who Hunger, Gather Gladly" (#509). It was written by Tennessee composer, William Moore. Not much is known about him other than his collection of hymns published in 1825.

Our tradition of singing the **Gloria Patri**, Latin for **Glory Be to the Father** is common to many denominations. This short hymn of praise was composed by Henry Greatorex (1813-1858). Henry was born on Christmas Eve in England, where his father was the organist at Westminster Abbey. He later came to America, and is buried in Charleston, South Carolina.
